## South Pymatuning Township Regular Meeting

The regular meeting of the South Pymatuning Township Board of Supervisors was held October 12, 2016 at 7:00PM in the municipal building with Chairperson Rose Lyons, Supervisors Brian Geisel, Michaelene Harris and Solicitor Victor Heutsche in attendance.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge to the flag.

A motion was made by Rose Lyons and seconded by Brian Geisel to approve the minutes of the September 14th, 2016 regular Meeting and to dispense with the reading of them. Motion passed unanimously.

It was announced that an Executive Session was held on September 19<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> to discuss personnel issues.

It was announced that Tri County has a scheduled leave pick up the week of 11/07/2016.

### Public Comments:

Bob Layman inquired about the recycling program. The supervisors discussed putting the program in place and are in agreement with moving forward. The solicitor will check into the ordinance.

Don Morrow asked if we are making any head way with Penn Dot concerning Buckeye Dr. of repairing the ditch. He also asked if there was any progress of getting the property cleaned up at the Tuna business.

Dennis Sump asked if an ordinance could be out into place for the number of cars that Tunas business has. Vic said he will check into it. He also asked about the police dept. if more manpower would be added. Supervisor Harris explained that the two new officers will be out on their own soon to help cover.

Bill Klumph would like to see Thompson Rd line painted.

Chuck Vranich asked if the township has become so safe that no laws are being broken and is concerned that no police reports are put in the newspaper. He asked who was responsible for the paperwork.
